

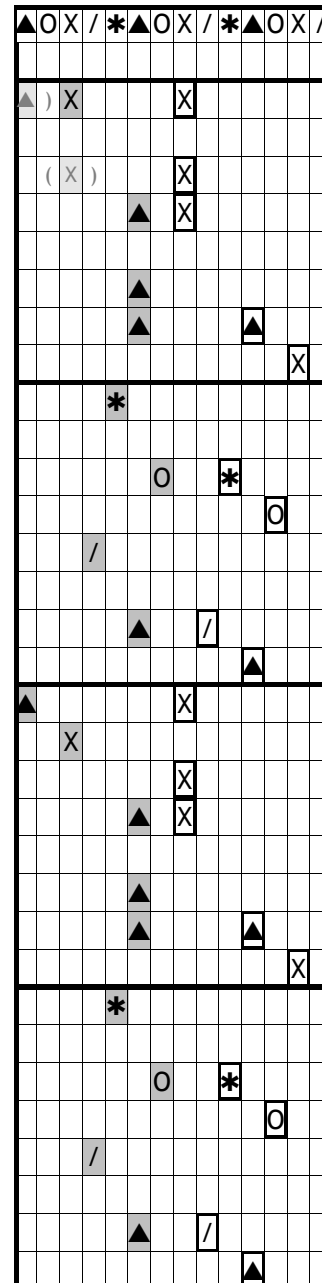
Yogolo Mansa
