Bada (*Badan, Badagbe*) is a Dunumba-rhythm from the Malinke, that is played as a transition between two other dununba's. It has a complete other rhythm compared to other dununba's. During the dance it offers the people that - in their enthusiasm - have closed to much on the drummers and each other, the opportunity to enlarge the circle around the players.
