Garankedon (*Garangedon, Garankefoli, Garanke or Sanja Garanke*) is a Malinke rhythm from the caste of the leatherworkers / shoemakers. *Garankefoli* is the name of the rhythm, *Garankedon* is the name of the dance. The dance used to be danced by the woman.
